









### **Policies and Procedures:**

In order for you and your child to have a rewarding and successful experience at Kinder Kids, we ask that you follow our policies and procedures outlined below:

# **Age Policy**

Kinder Kids accepts children at 2.5 years of age or older.

# **Toileting Guidelines**

Kinder Kids DOES NOT require all children be fully potty trained when beginning the program.

In the event your child needs to use the facilities during class time, said child's caregiver onsite will be called and asked to escort the child to the bathroom. Please, have your

child use the washroom prior to entering the class..

## **Snack Policy**

Please provide a snack for your child only. It should include 1 carb, 1 vegetable and 1 fruit – plus your water bottle! Please pack it in a container that can fit easily in a small basket.

Snack should be Litter-free.

We have a **NO NUT POLICY**, please check ingredients carefully.

### **Medication / Sickness**

Please inform the Instructors of any medical conditions. Please do not send a sick child e.g. feverish, cold, other communicable diseases.

### **Caregivers On-site**

We require all children to have a caregiver remain on-site and easily accessible during program time. There will be a space set-up for caregivers to work, socialize or take a break in (WiFi password provided). The gym is also available for those that have little ones with them. We ask that you please put anything out away (leave as you found it) and be out by 11am.

Caregiver does not need to be the parent. It can be a babysitter, neighbour, aunt, grandparent, etc. Anyone you approve to be the guardian onsite!
