Responsible To: Community Engagement Coordinator, Program Coordinator and Program Leaders

Primary Role: LIT is a leadership program for youth that have a genuine desire to work with children and develop their leadership skills. As a group, LITs will create unforgettable memories and lasting friendships as they work together during programs with HVNA. As individuals, each LIT will grow in confidence, make a difference in kids' lives, and be on their way to potential employment in the future. On a daily/weekly basis LITs will assist with daily program whether it's arts, crafts or games for children ranging in ages from 3-12 years, as well as, contribute to ensuring a safe and clean program site. Each LIT will work cooperatively with other LITs, Program Leaders, the Program Coordinator and report directly to the Community Engagement Coordinator.

Qualifications:

- An interest in working with children
- Past leadership development experience through schools, churches, clubs etc.
- Good communication skills and the ability to work with others
- Knowledge of songs, games, crafts etc.
- LEAD Certification
- High Five Certification
- Standard First Aid CPR C Highly Recommended

LIT Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist with the supervision of a small group of children and youth
- 2. Assist with activities such as crafts, songs, and games
- 3. Help participants respect and follow program rules
- 4. Ensure the safety of the participants at all times
- 5. Attend all appropriate program meetings and trainings
- 6. Work cooperatively with peers
- 7. Respect all participants, peers, staff, and yourself

- 8. Share suggestions for improving the program experience
- 9. Adhere to program rules and follow guidance of Program Leaders
- 10. Follow all policies and procedures as outlined in manual, including COVID-19 policies and procedures
- Maintain open lines of communication with parents; provide a high level of customer service to the public
- 12. Participate in self-evaluation and evaluations by Program Leaders and the Community Engagement Coordinator during and at the end of the program session
- 13. Follow designated dress code
- 14. Maintain confidentiality of information regarding participants, volunteers, program site, and staff

Goals of LIT Program for Each LIT:

- Plan and execute multiple games, crafts or other activities
- Practice first aid when it is necessary and needed
- Develop and understand individual leadership style
- Practice problem solving and conflict management skills
- Work as part of a team to develop teamwork skills
