Program Details

Below is a list of specific details for HVNA's *Leader In Training Camp* Program:

- The program will be hosted at Hespeler Arena, Beehive Hall (640 Ellis Road, Cambridge ON, N3C4N4)
- The program will run from 10am-2pm, Monday-Thursday
- The program will be 5 weeks long:
 - July 12th-15th, July 26th-29th, August 3rd-6th, August 9th-12th
- The program will cost \$50 per week (subsidies available)
- Each LIT will receive volunteer hours for the week(s) they attend (16 hours per week)
- 8 LITs per camp week are allowed to follow with COVID-19 pre-cautions
