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After School Program Guidelines 2021-2022

- HVNA's After School Program is available for any students grades 1-5. HVNA is only able to offer supervised pick up from St. Elizabeth and Woodland Park schools. Staff will arrange meeting spots at both schools and will assist with safe arrival to our After School Program site, Hespeler Arena.
- HVNA's After School Program is also available for other children grades 1-5 in the community if a parent/guardian can ensure their safe arrival.
- HVNA's After School Program requires kids to register and attend program Monday-Thursday in order to comply with the Ministry's guideline. If a participant has 3 unexplained absences, HVNA has the right to give your spot to another child.
- If your child cannot attend on a given day, HVNA requires a phone call or email letting us know of the scheduled absence.
- HVNA's After School Program is available on school days. After School Program is cancelled on PA Days, Statutory Holidays, school breaks and cancellations (E.g. Inclement weather).
- After School Program participants must be picked up no later than 5:30, \$1/minute late charge applies for late pick ups.
